## PROVENANCE = VALUE

In the Art and Antique worlds, provenance is value. The same is true for your projects. When you are planting Shumard red oaks in alkaline soils, you should know their provenance. Shumards grown from an alkaline seed source will not become chlorotic, degrading your project in years to come.

## HOW DO YOU KNOW?

Shumards are native over a large area of the U.S. In some areas, they grow near and readily hybridize with Pin oaks, Nuttall oaks or other red oaks. Their offspring, the acorns that may be collected and used to grow liners for landscape trees, will then exhibit traits of either, both or neither parent, including the inability to thrive in alkaline soils.

To ensure that you have alkaline-tolerant Shumards, the supplier of seeds must harvest from trees thriving in high-pH soils and the nursery grower must specify field liners from those seed sources.

Your supplier is the key: ask the nursery if their liner grower sources their Shumard acorns from trees growing in alkaline soils. Nurseries maintain records of their liners and can provide the answer. That's all you need to know to be sure the provenance of your Shumard oaks will add value, not disaster, to your project.
