Trees may have wounds from sapsuckers, sunscald, hail or similar events, collisions w/equipment, broken branches or leaders or significant pruning scars. Wounds may be recent or nearly healed.

PARK GRADE trees are excellent for mitigation, screening, filling in large areas and any other use where appearance is not of primary importance, particularly in the short term.
